Fri 13 July	Arrive Kanona. 08h00 Brunch outing at Kundalila Falls. Depart Kanona 13h00. Dinner on board. Pass through Mpika and Kasama overnight. 14h00 Arrive Nakonde/Tunduma for Zambian/Tanzanian border control. Breakfast, lunch and dinner on board 10h00 Arrive Makambako. Descend spectacular pass to Mlimba. 01h00 Arrive Kiduna and continue journey through Mzenga to Dar es Salaam. Breakfast on board. 10h00 Arrive Tazara Station, Dar Es Salaam

Dar Es Salaam to Capetown

Tue 17 July	07h00 Arrive Tunduma/Nakonde for Tanzanian/Zambian border control.
Wed 18 July	08h00 Arrive Kanona. Brunch outing at Kundalila Falls. Depart 12h00 Dinner on board. Pass through Lusaka
Thu 19 July	12h00 Pass through Kafue and Choma. Breakfast, lunch and dinner on board.
Fri 20 July	09h00 Arrive Livingstone for Zimbabwean border formalities before arriving Victoria Falls at 12h00. Transfer to the Victoria Falls Hotel. Sunset cruise on the Zambezi River.
Sat 21 July	African Spectacular Show. Dinner and overnight at the Victoria Falls Hotel. Day at leisure - tour of the Falls, game of golf, Flight of the Angels, river rafting, etc. Transfer to Station. 17h00
Sun 22 July	Depart Victoria Falls. Dinner and overnight on the train. 08h00 Pass by Bulawayo on route to Beitbridge with Breakfast, lunch and dinner on board. Overnight on train.
Mon 23 July	Breakfast & lunch on board. 18h00 Arrive Hoedspruit and transfer to 5-star Thornybush or Kapama Game Lodge for full board two-night stay.
Tue 24 July	After breakfast, guest activities i.e. Guided walk or game drive. Overnight stay Kapama or Thornybush.
Wed 25 July	Afternoon visit to Wild Dog and Cheetah Project. 18h00 Depart Hoedspruit on the Pride of Africa via Nelspruit to Pretoria.
Thu 26 July	10h00 Arrive Pretoria. Light lunch, City Tour of Pretoria. 16h30 depart Pretoria for Cape Town.
Fri 27 July	10h00 Arrive Kimberley. Visit to the Big Hole and the Diamond museum with historic tram ride.
